Before You Teach Your First 2020 Course:

For 2020 BLS, ACLS, and PALS Provider Courses:

- Go to [ShopCPR](https://ShopCPR.org) to "purchase" online exams (with or without eCards) so you're ready to assign exams to students during your classes

For 2020 ACLS and PALS Provider Courses:

- Determine if you'll be teaching the new course format using Precourse Work or teaching a "traditional" course
- Use the Sample Precourse Letters to Students (available in Instructor Manual or on [AHA Instructor Network](https://AHAInstructorNetwork.org)) to provide them direction for how to complete their Precourse Self-Assessments (required before class for both course formats) and Precourse Work (if using new course format)
